How your donations can make a difference:

£10

Buys **80 petri dishes** for growing cancer cells at the Ovarian Cancer Action Research Centre. Our cell biologists each use at least 80 dishes per week. With 47 scientists, that's over 3,500 petri dishes a week.

£15

Pays for **eight awareness raising packs** to help our supporters to raise the profile of ovarian cancer and to educate people about the disease.

£25

Will pay for **awareness materials** (posters, leaflets, etc) to be sent to six GP surgeries in your local area.

£125

Buys a **pipette for measuring** exact amounts of solution – known as “the scientist’s best friend”.

£250

Provides our researchers with **antibodies**, which are vital in the detection of cancer cell abnormalities.

£1,375

Provides **one month’s funding** for a junior scientist working at the Ovarian Cancer Action Research Centre.

£15,000

Pays for **research supplies** for one year for the Metabonomics Team studying the metabolic profiles of ovarian cancer.

£50,000

Pays for **one year’s salary** for a Principal Investigator working on the crucially important area of chemotherapy resistance.
